Sy is terug hospitaal toe, hier is sy na Baragwanath Hospitaal verwys vir die aborsie. Daar aangekom het hulle haar aangesê om die volgende dag terug te kom. Sy het by familie in JHB oorgeslaap. Daardie aand ontvang sy toe 'n oproep wat klein Blessed se hele toekoms verander het. Die pa van Blessed het haar gevra om nie met die aborsie voort te gaan nie!

Maria is nie terug vir die aborsie nie en Blessed is 23 Januarie gebore.

Later in Februarie het ons 'n oproep van Maria ontvang om ons te laat weet van Blessed se geboorte, sy het getuig dat hierdie seun 'n groot "Blessing" in haar lewe is en dat sy nie kon glo hy was amper nie! In Julie het sy ons verras en klein Blessed vir ons kom wys, hy is 'n pragtige seuntjie met lewendige ogies. Blessed se lewe is vir ons net weer 'n bewys die mens wik maar God beskik!

Maria is nog steeds sonder werk en sy en Blessed word deur familie in SA onderhou, kom ons stem saam en bid dat Abba Vader sal voorsien in hulle lewens.

BORN TO CARE'S STATISTICS

Since opening in March 2008 we have done 127 Counsellings.

- 27 babies that would have otherwise been aborted were born. Out of these babies:
 - 2 were given up for adoption
 - 25 are being raised by their parent/s today
- 4 miscarriages
- 1 baby died at birth
- 5 women were not pregnant
